Charlie Ester

**Charlie Ester
Surface Water Resources Manager – Salt River Project**

Charlie Ester is the Surface Water Resources Manager at the Salt River Project (SRP). SRP is a water and power utility founded in 1903 which serves the majority of the Phoenix metropolitan area. The Surface Water Resources group is responsible for weather forecasting in support of power and water operations, watershed monitoring, runoff forecasting, reservoir operations planning, flood emergency reservoir operations, and drought preparedness. Charlie is the past chairman of the Oak Creek Watershed Council, a member of Carpe Diem West's Leadership Team and Healthy Headwaters consortium, and promotes SRP's Watershed Stewardship role through an expanding internal monitoring effort, a research program with Arizona's universities, and by participation with the Forest Service and other collaborators on various forest and watershed restoration efforts. Charlie has been with SRP more than 34-years and is a 1983 Hydrology graduate of the University of Arizona. As always, continental breakfast will be provided.
